Dr. Larry Gurrola is the project manager and geomorphologist for The Project for Resilient Communities' study, which proposes a long-term Community Master Plan for reduction of flood and debris flow hazards. Registered as an engineering geologist, he provides consulting services for fault and landslides investigations including debris and mudflow mitigation in Santa Barbara and Ventura Counties. Dr. Gurrola mapped the geologic hazards, determined fault activities, and established alluvial fan ages from Ellwood to Carpinteria for his dissertation work at UC Santa Barbara.
